"Blessed are the God-Seekers"

(Based on Matthew 5-7, Philippians 2)

The collection of blessings in Matthew 5 can be summed up in this: blessed are those who seek to fulfill God's will in blessing His creation. The greatest commandment is for us to love the Lord our God completely; and the second greatest commandment is to love those in our lives as we love ourselves. God is supreme, and His supreme characteristic is loving everyone, so He calls you to love your neighbor, your friend, your coworker, your enemy - not more than yourself, not less than yourself, but like you love yourself.

Such love for God (and consequentially for others) drives us to do crazy things. It should drive us to do things differently than we usually do. In fact, the opposite, spiritual narcissism or making our religion all about us, is perhaps the main reason some churches languish and die. Each of us suffer when we focus on ourselves, when we stay in our bubble, and when we do not share Jesus in our community.

It's so easy to be spiritually narcissistic: we want to be saved, so we make sure we are perfected. We make it all about us. Paul complained to the Philippian church that he could only send Timothy to find out how they were doing, because everyone else he could send would be too focused on themselves to care about the Philippians! (Philippians 2:19-21). Do you know about the needs of your fellow church members, of your neighbors, of your co-workers; or are you too focused on making sure you're saved that you don't have the faintest idea? It is easy to say, my life is hard and busy, I do not have time for them. (Philippians 2:1-4)

It's so tempting to stay in our bubble rather than burst it and get wet in our community. Jesus tells us we are the salt and light of the world (Matthew 5:13-16). Salt is good for nothing if it stays with other salt. Light is good for nothing if it is hidden. The personification of the Beatitudes is Jesus. Jesus left His bubble and came to sin-ridden earth. He humbled Himself, became a servant, and left all earthly comforts and pleasures so He could connect with humanity. How do we stack up when we compare ourselves to Jesus? Do we huddle around our TV's after work, or do we visit our neighbor?

Seek God; put His Kingdom first, and God will figure out the rest (Matthew 6:33).

Weimar NEWSTART Program and the Eight Laws of Health #8

The Weimar NEWSTART Program uses the acronym NEWSTART to address the eight laws of health; N=Nutrition, E=Exercise, W=Water, S=Sunshine, T=Temperance, A=Air, R=Rest, and T=Trust in God. This article will focus on trust in God and is the final article. The following information is taken from seminar notes.

While the unbeliever may achieve some health by following the seven laws (of health), perfect health is only achieved by including the eighth law – the cooperation of human and divine power. Faith and trust in God undergird all the other health laws.

Miller Understands of Prophecy

"No prophecy of scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation, because no prophecy ever came by the impulse of man, but men moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God." 2 Peter 1: 20 & 21.

Miller was in good company in his interpretation of prophecy. Prophetic understanding divides into three major schools. Preterits view prophecy fulfillment as having taken place by the time or at the time of the writing of a prophetic book. Thus, for example, the book of Revelation is speaking primarily about events at the end of the first century of the Christian era.

Futurism, a second school of prophetic interpretation, holds that the bulk of apocalyptic prophecy will come to pass in a short space of time just before the Second Advent. The immensely popular *Left Behind series* of our day is grounded in futurism.

The third view, historicism, regards the fulfillment of prophecy as beginning in the time of the prophet, continuing across the spectrum of history, and climaxing at the Second Advent, this is what William Miller believed as he studied Daniel and Revelation.

The historicist understanding of prophecy is best illustrated in Daniel 2, whose fulfillment commenced during the lifetime of Nebuchadnezzar and Daniel, extended through the next three kingdoms that dominated the Mediterranean world. This led into the divisions of Rome, and reaches its fulfillment at the end of time with the arrival of God's kingdom. The visions in Daniel 7, 8, 9 and 10-12 replicates the historicist model, as does Revelation 12, which traces world history from the time of the Christ child and up to the end of time in verse 17, thus setting the final stage of end time events that unfolded in chapters 13-22 of the book of Revelation.

Miller was a historicist, as was the early church and nearly all protestant interpreters up through the middle of the nineteenth century. Futurism and Preterits, while capturing important aspects of Bible prophecy, didn't have much of a presence in Apocalyptic study until the reformation of Martin Luther, when certain expositors of the dominate Roman Catholic church sought to escape what they considered to be problematic historicist interpretations of such topics as the great red dragon and the whore of Babylon. The late nineteenth and twentieth centuries witnessed a surge of futurism and preterits, partly in response to the perceived failure of Millerism.

But the failure of Millers' Adventism hasn't changed the obvious historicist perspective of Daniel 2 or even the day for a year principle that was discovered by Miller. This was sound in the understanding of Daniel 9 that the Revised Standard Version translators rendered verse 24 as seventy weeks or years in spite of the fact that the Hebrew has only "seventy weeks." The addition was necessary even to individuals who didn't believe in predictive prophecy if they were to make sense of a prophecy claiming to extend from the time of the restoration of Jerusalem to the baptism of the Messiah, the death of Jesus and the stoning of Stephen.

Landmarks of "the Daily" (Part One)

(Written & Complied by R. LEE – 2009) "Then I saw in relation to the "Daily," that the word "sacrifice" was supplied by man's wisdom, and does not belong to the text; and that the Lord gave the correct view of it to those who gave the judgment hour cry. When union existed, before 1844, nearly all were united on the correct view of the "Daily;" but since 1844, in the confusion, other views have been embraced, and darkness and confusion has followed."

The Testimonies of William Miller

(The best way to bring out these historical facts concerning the Millerite view of "the Daily" in the book of Daniel is to let the writers speak for themselves, without comment from the compiler. So extracts from Millerite books, pamphlets and periodicals will be copied dealing with this subject, at the time the Judgment Hour Cry was being given to the world).

"And I could find no other case in which it was found, but in Daniel. I then took those words which stood in connection with it, 'take away.' He shall take away the daily. 'from the time the daily shall be taken away,' &c. I read on, and thought I should find no light on the text; finally I came to 2 Thess. ii. 7, 8. "For the mystery of iniquity doth already work, only he who now letteth, will let, until he be taken out of the way, and then shall that wicked be revealed," &c. And when I had come to that text, O, how clear and glorious the truth appeared! There it is! that is 'the daily!' Well, now, what does Paul mean by 'he who now letteth,' or hindereth? By 'the man of sin,' and 'the wicked,' Popery is meant. Well, what is it which hinders Popery from being revealed? Why it is Paganism; well, then, 'the daily' must mean Paganism."

MILLER'S LIFE AND VIEWS - BY JOSHUA V. HIMES - 1841, Pages 46 - 51: -

The next prophetic number to which we shall attend, will be Daniel viii. 14. "Unto 2300 days, then shall the sanctuary be cleansed, or justified." After Daniel had seen three visions, two of them including the whole "seven times," he sees under his last vision but the three last kingdoms, Persia, Grecia and Rome. He then hears a saint speaking, and another saint inquiring for how long time this last vision should be. Daniel was then informed, that it should be unto 2300 days. He afterwards heard a voice commanding Gabriel to make him (Daniel) understand the vision. He came and told him, that the vision would carry him to the end of all indignation, and at the time appointed (2300 days) the end would be. Gabriel then named two of the three kingdoms, i. e. Persia and Grecia, and described the Roman by its acts. Then he left Daniel to consider of the vision. Fifteen years afterwards, while Daniel was praying, Gabriel came to him again, and told Daniel he had come to make him understand the vision. Then he gives him the 70 weeks, and tells him plainly that the 70 weeks would seal (or make sure) the vision and prophecy. Here he gave him a clue to know when his vision of the ram and he-goat began. He tells Daniel plainly, and shows how those who should live after the 70 weeks were fulfilled, might know his prophecy to be true, and what they might understand by days in this vision. If, then, the 70 weeks were a part of the vision of the ram and he-goat, and given, as it is evident, for the express purpose of showing the beginning of the vision, it remains a simple problem. If 490 days were fulfilled in the year A. D. 33, by being so many years, when will 1810 days afterwards be fulfilled in the same manner? Answer, 1843.

Then in the twelfth chapter of Daniel, at the 7th verse, we have the three and a half times, which have been already explained in part, meaning 1260 days. See Rev. xii. 6 and 14: The woman in the wilderness, 1260 days, which is the same thing as three and a half times. Daniel, in the seventh chapter, 25th verse, mentions the little horn wearing out the saints three and a half times; but in the twelfth chapter, 7th verse, it is "scattering the power of the holy people" three and a half times. This was to be accomplished by the kings of the earth. Jer. l. 17: "Israel is a scattered sheep, the lions have driven him away; first the king of Assyria hath devoured him, and last this Nebuchadnezzar, king of Babylon, hath broken his bones." Also, Zech. i. 18-21.

Then in the twelfth chapter of Daniel, 11th verse: "And from the time that the daily *sacrifice*, (meaning abomination,) shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, there shall be 1290 days." There is some difficulty in knowing what is here intended by "daily sacrifice" in this text. It cannot mean the Jewish sacrifices, for two good reasons: -

- 1. It has some immediate connection with "the abomination that maketh desolate," i. e. Papacy, or papal power of Rome, that is "taken away, to set up," &c. Now all must admit that Jewish sacrifices were taken away about five hundred years before Papacy was set up, or exalted.
- 2. If Jewish sacrifices are here meant, then in A. D. 1360 this papal power would have ended her setting up, or exaltation. But Papacy was then at the height of its power. I have come to this conclusion: that this power, called "daily sacrifice," is Rome pagan abomination; the same as Christ has reference to in Matt. xxiv. 15. Luke xxi. 21.

Certainly Christ could not have reference to papal abomination that maketh desolate until Christ's second coming; for that was not set up until nearly five hundred years afterwards. Of course, it must have been the pagan abomination which would be taken away. This agrees with Paul, 2 Thes. ii. 3-10: "Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition: who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped: so that he, as God, sitteth in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God. Remember ye not that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things? And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time. For the mystery of iniquity doth already work:

For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way. And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan, with all power, and signs, and lying wonders, and with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the

I come from a long line of skinny people. So, why was I getting fat?

I am descended from a lineage of ridiculously healthy people who live far longer than other people. Why was I feeling like a physical wreck?

Finally, I figured it out. I live in the craziest place on Earth, nutritionally speaking, where the angels of health food gather around and whisper in one ear while the devils of junk food crowd gather around and whisper in the other ear.

This crazy place is the Inland Empire, home of the X spot where the world capital of plant-based nutrition, Loma Linda, butts up against the world capital of meat-based nutrition, San Bernardino.

I not only got wise to what's going on, I've now written a book about it, "The Healthiest People on Earth" (BenBella Books, available wherever books are sold – including Amazon.com).

My home town is Loma Linda, which is famous for its large population of Seventh-day Adventists and their huge medical center and their healthy lifestyle based on vegetarian nutrition, temperate habits, regular exercise and sound rest. Loma Linda also is renown as America's only entry on the short list of so-called Blue Zones, regions of Earth identified by National Geographic-supported research as being oases of healthy living where people live about a decade longer than others. (The other Blue Zones are Okinawa Island in Japan, the Barbagia region of Sardinia in Italy, the Nicoya Peninsula of Costa Rica, and the Greek island of Ikaria.)

OK, Loma Linda is where I was raised, but the place where I've worked and lived for most of my adult life is San Bernardino, which is Loma Linda's immediate next-door neighbor to the north. And San Bernardino is definitely not a Blue Zone. In fact, it's famous for being the birthplace of the fast-food revolution, where McDonald's, Taco Bell, Der Wienerschnitzel, Del Taco, Baker's, Taco Tia and other chains got their start.

So, here I am, an apparently impressionable fellow raised and inspired in Loma Linda, then tempted and beguiled in San Bernardino.

It's a Jekyll and Hyde situation.

I'm definitely an expert on the whole Blue Zone thing. In fact, I'm an insider of a special kind. I'm the great-great-grandson of Ellen G. White, the founder and prophet of the Seventh-day Adventist church, who established Loma Linda in 1905 as the bastion of the worldwide Adventist health ministry. My grandfather, Herbert C. White, was the author of many health books. My father, Howard B. Weeks, was a longtime Loma Linda University administrator.

But, you know what? I'm also an expert on getting my kicks on Route 66. I grew up to become a career journalist based at the San Bernardino Sun. And I've lived in San Bernardino for 35 years.



"We all desire immediate and direct answers to our prayers, and are tempted to become discouraged when the answer is delayed or comes in an un-looked-for form. But God is too wise and good to answer our prayers always at just the time and in the manner, we desire. He will do more and better for us than to accomplish all our wishes. And because we can trust His wisdom and love, we should not ask Him to concede to our will, but should seek to enter into and accomplish His purpose. Our desires and interests should be lost in His will." Gospel Workers, p. 219

When you recognize that some of your past habits may have contributed to your sickness, then it's time to "trust. Notice this quote, "The relation that exists between the mind and body is very intimate. When one is affected, the other sympathizes. The condition of the mind affects the health to a far greater degree than many realize. Many of the diseases from which men suffer are the result of mental depression. Grief, anxiety, discontent, remorse, guilt, distrust, all tend to break down the life forces to invite decay and death." *My Life Today,* p. 151. truth, that they might be saved." Here Paul shows plainly, that there was one abomination then at work, which would hinder the rise of the last abomination, until the first was "taken out of the way." Then the second would be Western empire of Rome, which were to arise up and rule one hour, $\square \square$ (a little time,) with the beast, pagan: for this little horn was to arise or be "set up" among the ten horns. It could not be until after the year 476 after Christ, when the Western empire fell, and was divided into ten kingdoms. It could not come until "they," the ten kings, had "polluted the sanctuary of strength," (meaning Rome.) Dan. xi. 31: "And they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall 'take away' the daily sacrifice, and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate." Who shall do this? I answer, the ten horns, or kings. Rev. xvii. 12, 13: "And the ten horns which thou sawest are ten kings, which have received no kingdom as yet, (when John saw his vision,) but receive power as kings one hour, (a short time,) with the beast." The beast here must mean Rome pagan, for we have been told that beast means a kingdom. Daniel vii. 23: "Thus he said, the fourth beast shall be the fourth kingdom upon earth." And as papal Rome had not yet been "set up," we must of necessity call this beast Rome pagan. Then he tells us, Rev. xvii. 13, "These (ten kings) have one mind," that is, one faith, all being converted to the orthodox religion of the Catholic Roman Church, "and shall give their power and strength to the beast," meaning Rome papal; for now this beast is "set up," and the ten kings have given their power and strength to the pope of Rome, and the woman or Papacy sits upon the scarlet colored beast having seven heads and ten horns revealed, whom the Lord would destroy with the brightness of his coming. The question then would be, when was Paganism taken out of the way? I answer, it must have been after the ten horns arose out of what is called the have one mind," that is, one faith, all being converted to the orthodox religion of the Catholic Roman Church, "and shall give their power and strength to the beast," meaning Rome papal; for now this beast is "set up," and the ten kings have given their power and strength to the pope of Rome, and the woman or Papacy sits upon the scarlet colored beast having seven heads and ten horns.

Then the abomination that maketh desolate began his rule in the fourth kingdom, when "the dragon (emperor of the Eastern empire) gave him his power, his seat, (Rome,) and great authority," (Rev. xiii. 2,) and when the ten kings give their power and strength to him, and he (the pope) uses his authority over the kings of the earth. (See Rev. xvii. 18.) "And the woman thou sawest is that great city, which reigneth over the kings of the earth." These several marks, and combinations of events, and circumstances, in my opinion, can nowhere be fulfilled in any manner agreeing with the prophecy, except in the conversion of the pagan kings to Christianity, which happened as soon as A. D. 508; then they "must continue a short space," Rev. xvii. 10; which is shown in Daniel to be thirty years, the difference between Dan. vii. 25 and xii. 11, the last number, 1290 years, beginning at the "taking away" Paganism, A. D. 508; the first number, 1260 years, beginning at the setting up of Papacy, A. D. 538, when the dragon gave his power, his seat and great authority, and when the ten kings gave their power and strength to Rome papal, and he exerciseth the power of the pagan beast before him. Papacy now killed heretics, as Paganism had Christians before. Then these numbers would end in the year A. D. 1798, allowing a day for a year.

The events which took place in the year 1798, are strong evidence that my calculations of these numbers are correct. Papacy then lost the power to punish heretics with death, and to reign over the kings of the earth. All must agree that Papacy has no temporal power over any kingdom, except the little kingdom of Italy, one of the horns of which the ten are composed. It is very evident, too, that the church is not now in the wilderness, and the time, times and a half of the church in the wilderness were fulfilled when free toleration was given to all religions in Italy, France, Spain, Portugal, &c.; where Bonaparte obtained power and granted free toleration. Also, the two witnesses are not clothed in sackcloth, and the 1260 years are fulfilled. No one can doubt for a moment that the Bible was forbidden to the common people, and forbidden to be translated in any common language, after the orthodox put down the Arian heresy in Italy and the West, by Bellisarius, the general of Justinian's troops, sent into Africa and Italy for the express purpose of suppressing the Arian power, and giving the Church of Rome the preeminence over all schismatics. Then was the Bible taken from the common people, and remained in a sackcloth state from A. D. 538 until A. D. 1798, during 1260 years. Here we find the prophetic time of days fulfilled in years, by two ways more. And now it remains to show the end, by Dan. xii. 11, 12. "And from the time that the daily sacrifice shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, there shall be 1290 days." Paganism taken away A. D. 508; add 1290, makes 1798. "Blessed is he that waiteth, and cometh to the 1335 days: but go thou thy way until the end be, for thou shalt rest and stand in thy lot at the end of the days." by two ways more. When will the end of these days be? you may inquire. I answer, 1335 years from taking away the first abomination of the Roman kingdom, A. D. 508, to which add 1335 and it makes A. D. 1843, when Daniel will stand in his lot, and all who have waited for the Lord will be blessed. This led Mr. Miller to believe that the "daily" of Daniel was Paganism, or idolatry.

SYNOPSIS OF MILLER'S VIEWS - BY WILLIAM MILLER - WRITTEN JANUARY 1, 1843, Pages 28, 29, 33 & 34:

IX. It can also be proved by Daniel xii. 11-13, "And from the time that the daily sacrifice shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, there shall be a thousand two hundred and ninety days. Blessed is he that waiteth, and cometh to the thousand three hundred and five and thirty days. But go thou thy way till the end be: for thou shalt rest, and stand in thy lot at the end of the days." The number 1335 days, from the taking away of Rome Pagan, A. D. 508, to set up Rome Papal, and the reign of Papacy, is 1290 days, which was exactly fulfilled in 1290 years, being fulfilled in 1798. This proves the 1335 days to be years, and that Daniel will stand in his lot in A. D. 1843. For proof texts, see Dan. xi. 31, "And arms shall stand on his part, and they shall pollute the sanctuary of strength, and shall

take away the daily sacrifice, and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate." 2 Thess. ii. 6-8, "And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time. For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way. And then shall that wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming:" Job. xix. 25, "For I know that my Redeemer liveth, and that he shall stand at the latter day upon the earth:" [Miller's Lectures page 100.]

XV. It can be proved by the numbers in Rev. xiii. 18, "Here is wisdom. Let him that hath understanding count the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is six hundred threescore and six," connected with Daniel xii. 12, as before quoted. This text shows the number of years that Rome would exist under the blasphemous head of Paganism, after it was connected with the people of God by league, beginning B. C. 158, add 666 years, will bring us to A. D. 508, when the daily was taken away. Then add Dan. xii. 12, the 1335 to 508, makes the year 1843. When the beast and his image will be tormented in the presence of the holy angels, and the Lamb. See Rev. xiv. 9-12. "And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand, the same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb: and the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name. Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus." – [Miller's Lectures, page 76.].

The Midnight Cry, February 22, 1844: - "In the evening, Mr. Miller lectured upon the number of the beast, in Rev." "He was unusually clear, and seemed to carry conviction to many, of the correctness of his application of this prophecy. He remarked that his Advent brethren had not generally agreed with his views of it, and that satisfied him that they studied the scriptures for themselves, and followed him only so far as they believed he followed the word of God. He was however, fully satisfied that the number of the beast 666 could only denote the years of pagan Roman supremacy from B. C. 158 to A. D. 508." As the majority of Adventists were **NOT** united before 1844 on Br. Miller's teaching on this point, his teaching concerning 666 and "the daily" does **NOT** come under the inspired endorsement of the statement from the Testimony of Jesus found in The Present Truth.

{May the Lord bless and guide the honest in heart reader as you carefully study these materials. And may this Study Document be used to help establish you in the original Advent message, so that you will not be led away with the various winds of false doctrines that are blowing today.} Our next month topic for **The Landmarks of "the Daily"** is: The Testimony of Sylvester Bliss.

Brown Rice Pudding

From the *Naturally Gourmet Cookbook* by Karen Houghton. Submitted by Jane Gerndt.

Very good! We use this pudding as a dessert but it is listed under the breakfast recipes. It is great as a cereal too! I use fresh pineapple.

2 cups cooked brown rice

½ cup chopped dates

½ cup chopped raisins

½ cup raw cashews

1/4 tsp cinnamon

½ cup dried or fresh chopped pineapple

2/3 cup or enough water to blend

1 Tbsp honey or maple syrup

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Mix rice, dates, raisins, cinnamon and pineapple in a bowl. Blend cashews, water and honey until creamy. Add blended ingredients to rice mixture and combine well. Place in a well-oiled casserole dish and bake for 30 minutes. We eat it as is but you can serve it warm with soymilk or pear cream.
