Hebrews 13:8 - "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever." 1 John 4:1 - "Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but test the spirits, whether they are of God" God will not contradict Himself, though He may contradict our preconceptions about Him. If the voice in your head contradicts the Bible, then you know it is not from God.

As for the questions regarding killing someone, the short answer is God is not calling you to kill someone. There are only a handful of times in the Bible that God calls someone to kill someone, and there are very specific circumstances required; circumstances such as being a king or a nation called to enact God's judgment upon another nation. Those reading this district newsletter do not fit those circumstances, so the answer is no. If you remain unconvinced, study the mercy and long-suffering of God in the Bible, and the nonviolence of Jesus our Example.



THAI SWEET POTATOE SOUP

This soup is made with pureed sweet potatoes, ginger, lime, coconut milk and curry paste with just a hint of spice.

Prep time: 10 minutes Cook time: 20 minutes Total time: 30 minutes

Ingredients:

- 1 Tbsp. olive oil
- 3 cloves garlic, peeled and minced
- 3-inch piece fresh ginger, peeled and minced
- 2-3 Tbsp. green or red curry paste
- 4 medium sweet potatoes, cooked and peeled
- 1 1/2-2 tsp. coarse salt
- 4 cups unsalted vegetable stock

Zest and juice of 2 medium limes

- 1 1/2 tsp. granulated sugar
- 1 (15 oz.) can coconut milk

Pinch cayenne pepper (optional)

Fresh cilantro leaves and coconut flakes, for garnish

Directions:

- 1. In a Dutch oven or stock pot, heat oil to medium-high. Add garlic and ginger and saute 30-60 seconds, until fragrant. Add curry paste and stir. Add sweet potatoes. Whisk in stock, and bring to a simmer. Allow to cook 12-15 minutes. Puree, until smooth, with an immersion blender.
- 2. Whisk in lime zest and juice, sugar, coconut milk and cayenne (if using). Taste and adjust seasoning, if necessary.
- 3. Serve with cilantro and coconut flakes.
