John 18:36 "Jesus answered, My kingdom is not of this world: if my kingdom were of this world, then would my servants fight, that I should not be delivered to the Jews: but now is my kingdom not from hence."

What things in this world are you willing to argue and fight for? Your political stance? Your favorite social issue?

In Christ's day, one of the issues at hand was the Roman occupation of Israel. Interest in politics took over the lives of many. The Zealot's revolts against the Romans shed much blood on both sides. Fighting and skirmishes were common but Israel was never advanced by the use of force or political intrigue. How many people were brought to salvation through any of this fighting? How far was the gospel spread into gentile nations when God's people were so focused on the political and social issues that surrounded them? Were these issues important in some way? Sure they were, but how was God's heavenly kingdom built up when the people were so focused in the fallen world around them? With eyes looking downward, how can anyone see what's above them?

Greed for money and power consumed many others. Corrupt tax collectors and swindlers were a drain on the

people. Even those that worked for the church, inflated prices for the sanctuary sacrifices that built barriers to the doorway to salvation and made it even more difficult to seek God, even in his own house. Perhaps the money stolen from God's people was going to be used to build up and beautify the physical structure of the temple, but how did impoverishing the worshipers bring them closer to God when they could see the priests becoming richer and richer?

Jesus' closest disciples were not immune to the focus on worldly things while omitting the heavenly. Repeatedly they were found arguing about who was the greatest. Judas, trying to enrich himself, frequently had his hands in money bags that were supposed to be helping the poor. Jesus would often have to draw their attention away from the world or they might have found themselves wondering far away from salvation.

Here is a passage from Ellen White's The Desire of Ages page 509, "But today in the religious world there are multitudes who, as they believe, are working for the establishment of the kingdom of Christ as an earthly and temporal dominion. They desire to make our Lord the ruler of the kingdoms of this world, the ruler in its courts and camps, its legislative halls, its palaces and market places. They expect Him to rule through legal enactments, enforced by human authority. Since Christ is not now here in person, they themselves will undertake to act in His stead, to execute the laws of His kingdom. The establishment of such a kingdom is what the Jews desired in the days of Christ. They would have received Jesus, had He been willing to establish a temporal dominion, to enforce what they regarded as the laws of God, and to make them the expositors of His will and the agents of His authority. But He said, "My kingdom is not of this world." John 18:36. He would not accept the earthly throne.

The government under which Jesus lived was corrupt and oppressive; on every hand were crying abuses,—extortion, intolerance, and grinding cruelty. Yet the Saviour attempted no civil reforms. He attacked no national

Breakfast Burrito (Serves 6-8)

2 lbs potatoes cubed into bite size pieces

1 TBSP Olive Oil

½ tsp each, salt & garlic powder

1/4 tsp each cumin, chili powder

1 TBSP Cornstarch

5 eggs

½ - 1 onion, finely diced

1 medium red pepper, chopped

4 oz. mushrooms (optional)

Salt and seasonings to taste for egg & veggie mixture

 $\frac{1}{4}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ cup chopped cilantro

1 cup cooked pinto or black beans

½ cup shredded cheese (Optional)

6-8 TBSP favorite salsa

Directions:

Preheat oven to 400. Line a backing sheet with parchment paper. Add cubed potatoes to backing sheet and toss with olive oil and salt, garlic powder, cumin, chili powder and corn starch. Spread potatoes in an even layer and bake for 25-30 minutes or until fork tender and golden in some places.

Heat skillet over medium heat. Add onions and cook for 1 minute. Add peppers and mushrooms and cook for another few minutes until everything is tender but not too soft. Add eggs and scramble with the onions, peppers and mushrooms. Season to taste. Add beans. Warm tortillas. Spread with potatoes and veggie/egg/bean mixture. Roll up the burrito. Serve with your favorite salsa and toppings. If you are freezing the burritos for later, let them cool, then wrap in plastic wrap or parchment paper, put in freezer safe bag. Freeze. When ready to eat, microwave about 2 minutes until warmed through.

Landmarks of the "the Daily" (Part Two)

The Testimony of Sylvester Bliss and L.C. Collins

(INCONSISTENCIES OF COLVER'S LITERAL FULFILMENT OF DANIEL'S PROPHECY. – BY S. BLISS – 1843, Pages 12 & 51)

On page 33, Mr. Colver says, "Daniel viii. 13: "Then I heard one saint speaking, and another saint said unto that certain saint which spake, How long shall be the vision concerning the daily sacrifice, and the transgression of desolation, to give both the sanctuary and the host to be trodden under foot?' Mark well this inquiry. It is not, How long shall be the time for everything that Daniel saw in the vision; but 'How long shall be the vision concerning the daily sacrifice,' &c." Now if he were honest, he would have informed his readers, that the words sacrifice and concerning are not in the original, and are so noted in the translation, and that the question is literally, "How long the VISION – the daily and the transgression of desolation, to give both the sanctuary and the host to be trodden under foot?" Neither is the word sacrifice in the original of Dan. xii. 11-13; so that it reads "from the time the daily shall be taken away, and the abomination that maketh desolate set up, there shall be 1290 days. Blessed is he that waiteth, and cometh to the thousand three hundred and five and thirty days. But go thou thy way till the end be; for thou shalt rest, and stand in thy lot at the end of the days."

... VII. The 1290 and 1335 days in Daniel 12, are also proved to be years for the 1290 days were to reach to the time of the end, and in A. D. 1798, just 1290 years from the taking away of the daily, A. D. 508, were fulfilled the very events that were predicted in Dan. xi. 40-45 is to occur at the time of the end. The 1335 days would therefore extend 45 years beyond, and terminate in 1843; and that they reach to the end of the world is evident, from the fact that Daniel will then stand in his lot. "Blessed is he that waiteth, and cometh to the thousand three hundred and five and thirty days. But go thou thy way till the end be; for thou shalt rest, and stand in thy lot at the end of the days."

PARAPHRASE OF DANIEL XI. AND XII. – BY S. BLISS – 1844 – COMMENTS ON DANIEL 11:31 & 12:11 – 13:-

And [those that take up] arms shall stand on his part. And they [the barbarians from the north of Europe] shall pollute [Rome] the sanctuary of strength, and [shall conquer the empire, out of which ten kingdoms, corresponding with the ten toes of the image, and horns of the fourth beast, shall arise. These ten kings being converted to Christianity] shall take away the daily sacrifice [of the pagan rites, about A. D. 508] and they shall place the abomination that maketh desolate [in its place – the Man of Sin, - Papacy, the Wicked to be revealed when that which hindered is taken out of the way, 2 Thess. ii.] ... And from the time that the daily sacrifice [of Paganism, about A. D. 508,] shall be taken away, and the abomination [of papacy] that maketh desolate shall be set up [to the time of the end, when knowledge shall be increased on this subject,] there shall be one thousand two hundred and ninety days [1290 years.] Blessed is he that waiteth and cometh to the

abuses, nor condemned the national enemies. He did not interfere with the authority or administration of those in power. He who was our example kept aloof from earthly governments. Not because He was indifferent to the woes of men, but because the remedy did not lie in merely human and external measures. To be efficient, the cure must reach men individually, and must regenerate the heart." DA 509

In our world today, the Christian political right is trying to legislate their beliefs onto the largely unbelieving country. Will legally forcing people to follow the popular churches beliefs bring people closer to God? Did Jesus force anyone into submission?

We can plainly see that the world's morals are crumbling around us. But we also know from prophecy that this disintegration is only going to get worse instead of better. The bible says that our world will be just like the days of Noah, "the wickedness of man was great on the earth, and that every imagination of the heart was only evil continually." Genesis 6:5. The bible also compares our day to the days of Lot. Do you remember what Sodom and Gomorra were like? We know our world is falling apart but the fix is not found in our own strength. The remedy is not found in brute force, or legislating new laws, or in acquiring more wealth, or in strong arming our friends and family. The only way to truly change the world begins with Jesus. Our lives will transform only as we submit to Jesus, as we individually come to God.

Here is a continuation from the passage in The Desire of Ages, "Not by the decisions of courts or councils or legislative assemblies, not by the patronage of worldly great men, is the kingdom of Christ established, but by the implanting of Christ's nature in humanity through the work of the Holy Spirit. "As many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on His name: which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God." John 1:12, 13. Here is the only power that can work the uplifting of mankind. And the human agency for the accomplishment of this work is the teaching and practicing of the word of God." DA 509

This is why Jesus said His kingdom was not of this world. Jesus' last lessons to his disciples during the last supper on Easter weekend were some of the most life changing passages in the Bible. In John 14 Jesus tells us that he alone in this entire broken world is the sole and exclusive way, truth and Life. In John chapter 15 Jesus tells us that he is the true vine and we are the branches. The only way to find true life is being totally submitted to Him and His Word. If we try to live life in a way that is contrary to God, we lose the only source to salvation. "I am the vine, ye are the branches: he that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing." John 15:5.

thousand three hundred and five and thirty days, [1335 years from about A. D. 508.] But go thou thy way till the end [of these wonders] be: for thou shalt rest and stand in [for] thy lot, [in the resurrection] at the end of the [1335] days.

The Testimony of L.C. Collins

THE SIGNS OF THE TIMES, AND EXPOSITOR OF PROPHECY, OCTOBER 19, 1842: -

The question is asked, "How long shall be the vision?" The answer is, unto 2300 days. Here then the length of this vision, ending with all earthly things, is positively given, and we cannot deny it if we will believe plain Bible. Again, Daniel is told that at the end of 1335 days from the taking away of one great persecuting power (Paganism) brought to view in the vision, and the setting up of the abomination that maketh desolate (Papacy) he should stand in his lot (be raised from the dead) and all those who wait on the Lord – that are found watching and ready – shall be blessed.

Now the question is, why are these dates which take hold on eternity revealed to us? Yes, Christian, why?

Who but an infidel would say but it was for our benefit? But these dates can be of no possible benefit to us, unless understood before they terminate. And if understood, then we have the time when all earthly things shall close. These things were to be sealed up until the time of the end; then knowledge was to be increased, the seal broken, and the wise to understand. That time has now come, Dan. xi. 40. Even the way-faring man clearly sees that the seventy weeks instruction is the key to unlock the vision. Says Gabriel, "understand the matter and consider the vision. Seventy weeks are determined," that is seventy weeks of it are "cut off" upon thy people; for so the highest authority renders it. Seventy weeks of it are "cut off" to accomplish the events which were accomplished by the death of Christ. The seventy weeks were to commence with the going forth of the commandment. This commandment was given to Ezra, vii. 11., in the 7th year of Artaxerxes. From that decree to the death of Christ, is just 490 years; the number of days in seventy weeks; showing that each day stands for a year. Num. xiv. 34; Ezra iv. 5, 6. Then as 490 years of the vision expired with the death of Christ, there would be left of the 2300 days (years) but 1810 after that before the vision must end. 1810 years reckoned from the 33rd of the Christian era (the crucifixion) would bring us down to 1843.

The 1335, which was to commence with the setting up of Popery, closed at the same time: Paganism closed among the ten kingdoms into which the Roman empire was divided, in 508, at which time Papacy was set up. From thence,it was to stand as a ruling power 1290 days (years) Dan. xii. 11., when its dominion was to be taken away. This would bring us to 1798, in which year the Pope was taken and carried to France, Italy made a republic, which, says Dr. Adam Clark, "entirely superceded the whole Papal power." With the rare certainty then that this was done, Daniel, with all that sleep in Christ, will be raised from the dead next year. For reckoning back 490 years from 1798, when the papal power lost its dominion – which it certainly has, unless it can be shown that the saints of the Most High are now in its hands – and we are brought to 508, where history shows that it was set up in the place of Paganism, by the kings of the earth. Then in 1335 days (years) from this Daniel was to stand in his lot. 1335 years after 508 brings us to 1843.

Mexican Fruit Salad

½ small jicama (about ½ - ¾ lbs.) peeled, diced

- 2 Lg Mangos, peeled, seeded and cut into ½" cubes
- 3 Cups watermelon, peeled, seeded and cut into 1/2" cubes
- 1 ½ Cups cantaloupe, peeled, seeded and cut into ½" cubes
- 1 Large cucumber, peeled, seeded and cut into ½" cubes
- 2-3 Tbsp lime juice (2-3 limes)
- 2-3 Tbsp fresh cilantro, finely chopped (Optional)

Pinch of salt (Optional)

Tajin seasoning

Directions:

Combine the cut fruit in a bowl. Pour the lime juice over the fruit. Add the cilantro and Tajin seasoning and toss gently to mix well. Chill in the refrigerator before serving. (Or let people put on their own seasoning as needed)

One last passage from Ellen White's book Christ's Object Lessons, pages 67 to 69, "There can be no growth or fruit-fulness in the life that is centered in self. If you have accepted Christ as a personal Saviour, you are to forget yourself, and try to help others. Talk of the love of Christ, tell of His goodness. Do every duty that presents itself. Carry the burden of souls upon your heart, and by every means in your power seek to save the lost. As you receive the Spirit of Christ—the Spirit of unselfish love and labor for others—you will grow and bring forth fruit. The graces of the Spirit will ripen in your character. Your faith will increase, your convictions deepen, your love be made perfect. More and more you will reflect the likeness of Christ in all that is pure, noble, and lovely. COL 67.3

"The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance." <u>Galatians</u> <u>5:22, 23</u>. This fruit can never perish, but will produce after its kind a harvest unto eternal life. COL 68.1

"When the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come." Christ is waiting with longing desire for the manifestation of Himself in His church. When the character of Christ shall be perfectly reproduced in His people, then He will come to claim them as His own. COL 69.1

Somewhat satisfied but still wondering, the youngster went on his way. Not long afterwards, his saintly old grandfather took the little boy on a fishing trip. They were having a great time together – it had been an ideal day. The sun was beginning to set with unusual splendor as the day ended.

The old man stopped fishing and turned his full attention to the exquisite beauty unfolding before him. Can anybody, (hesitating) can anybody ever really see God?"
