Please ponder these words by Ellen White:

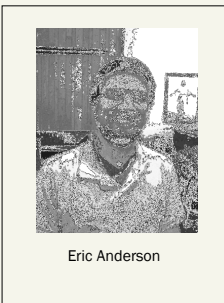

“THE SIN OF LYING”

The following week, as he prepared to deliver his sermon, the minister asked for a show of hands. He wanted to know how many had read Mark 17. Every hand went up.

The minister smiled and said, "Mark has only sixteen chapters. I will now proceed with my sermon on the sin of lying."

Persecution of Christian is rampant in several areas of the world. Christians are losing their homes, family members and even being killed for their faith on a daily basis in the worst areas. Here at home, it is becoming increasingly difficult to share our faith. Prophecy says all this has to happen before the great day of the Lord. Wars will increase in their severity, families will turn on each other and long time loving relationships will turn bitterly cold (Matthew 24). With the time of trouble such as we have never seen approaching (Daniel 12), we need the stability and steadfastness of God for support. We must stay close to Jesus, because He is the only way we will make it through the soon coming crisis about to swallow the whole world. While reflecting on the recent terror events in

Europe I read this beautiful Psalm and saw new hope in it that I had never seen before.

Psalm 67 from the NASB

Let all the peoples praise You.

4. Let the nations be glad and sing for joy;

For You will judge the peoples with uprightness

Let all the peoples praise You.

6. The earth has yielded its produce;

God, our God, blesses us.

7. God blesses us,
That all the ends of the earth may fear Him.

After reading this psalm I had to ask myself some hard questions. Can I pray this Psalm, even in bitter persecution? Even when I feel Discouraged? Even when the devil seems to have the victory? When there is bloodshed? When there is betrayal? When everyone I know and love are gone, can I still say this prayer?

1. Help me to walk in your way. Help me to see your path, even when death looms near.

2. You are the only salvation we have. You are the only path through the devastation of sin.

Why do we pray for Church Unity

We have the most wonderful time praying about church unity. This will be largely based on Ephesians 4. It has to do with the simple things, but very solid doctrine about the Church. Listen closely to Paul's opening statement. The first of these are humility:

1 I therefore, a prisoner for the Lord, urge you to walk in a manner worthy of the calling to which you have been called, 2 with all humility and gentleness, with patience, bearing with one another in love, 3 eager to maintain the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. (Eph. 4:1-3)

This humility is and has been, that which is required for praying for the Church. I have learned that when one prays, one must be meek:

8 He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? (Mic.6:8)

It is proof of righteousness in plain sight of man's propensity to be humble.

1 "The whole commandment that I command you today you shall be careful to do, that you may live and multiply, and go in and possess the land that the Lord swore to give to your fathers. 2 And you shall remember the whole way that the Lord your God has led you these forty years in the wilderness, that he might humble you, testing you to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep his commandments or not. (Deut. 8:1-2)

God is so great that He had mercy on those who had chosen to follow Him through the dessert. He knew it would require much to be able to give His only son for them. The blessings from the Lord are able to be multiplied and focused on a person until one is perfected. The benefits of following humility are numerous:

29 For when they are humbled you say, 'It is because of pride'; but he saves the lowly. (Job 22:29)

Job is the most careful of the prophets and Matthew says:

"But he that is greatest among you shall be your servant." (Mat. 23:11)

This is repeated throughout the New Testament, in Luk 14:11, Jam 4:6, 1Pet 5:5 to name a few. The Old Testament has many references which relate the reader to humility, but by far the most clear on the Church is by Isaiah:

15 For thus says the One who is high and lifted up, who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: I dwell in the high and holy place, and also with him who is of a contrite and lowly spirit, to revive the spirit of the lowly, and to revive the heart of the contrite. 16 For I will not contend forever, nor will I always be angry; for the spirit would grow faint before me, and the breath of life that I made. 17 Because of the iniquity of his unjust gain I was angry, I struck him; I hid my face and was angry, but he went on backsliding in the way of his own heart. 18 I have seen his ways, but I will heal him; I will lead him and restore comfort to him and his mourners, 19 creating the fruit of the lips. Peace, peace, to the far and to the near," says the Lord, "and I will heal him. 20 But the wicked are like the tossing sea; for it cannot be quiet, and its waters toss up mire and dirt. 21 There is no peace," says my God, "for the wicked." (Isa 57:15-21)

It says it all about praying for Church unity in his time, and for us.

Church Plant Meeting

Where we are: The Wautoma church planting meetings are continuing on schedule. We are finalizing a location for where the church will be meeting. During the meetings, we have looked at some of the demographics of the city to help point out where our ministry focus should be. We discovered that Wautoma specifically, and Waushara county as a whole is a lower income area with a growing Hispanic community. The city also has a large percentage of the population made up of young families. This is good to know because these are exactly the kind of people the current Wautoma Seventh-Day-Adventist Community Center serves. The Community Center is a ministry that has been in operation in Wautoma for generations and provides very inexpensive clothing and other household goods to the community at a very low price in hopes of helping families in need.

Where we hope to be soon: The Wautoma Seventh-Day-Adventist Community Center has been running for years but the building needs some improvements. It is my hope that as our small group of worshipers begins to meet somewhere in Wautoma, we can begin fixing up the Community Center building and make it a beacon of light in the city for Jesus.

We are still in the beginning stages of planting but Wautoma already has seen people going door-to-door making friends in the community. Prayer is the primary thing that we need. We need all the prayer that we can get. As we look to the future, it is the Lord that will provide. It is the Lord that will bring souls to salvation. We all need to be willing to move when Jesus comes calling our name. Our meetings are scheduled to move to Wautoma in January.
